Objectives:

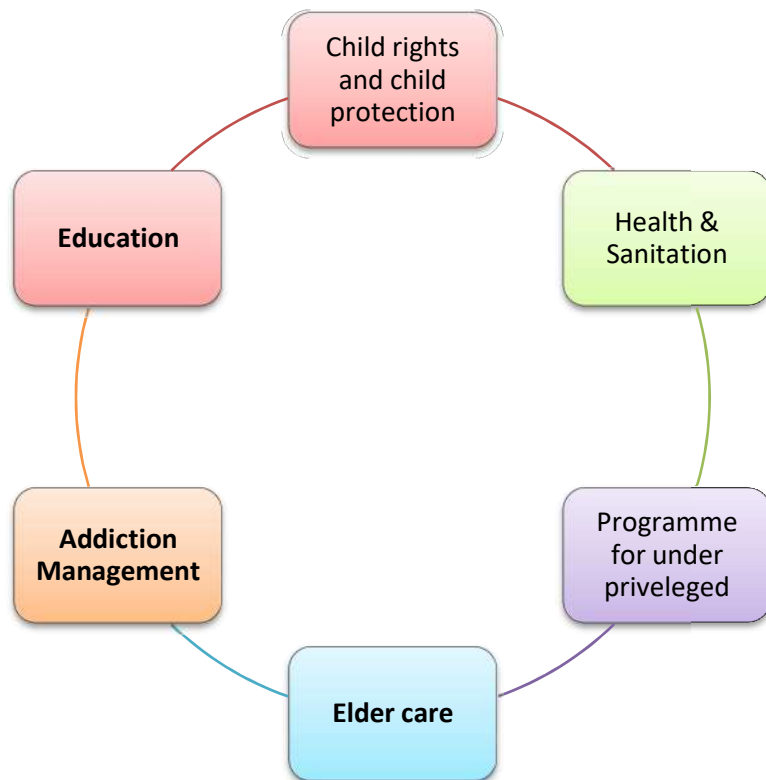
- i. To carryout the plans and the aims of the State and Central Governmental programmes which is sponsored by the concerned authorities.

AMKS has collaborated with various partners and executed ample of developmental and right based programmes for the marginalized and succeeded in its commendable work. The partners associated with AMKS are the Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment, Local donors and service minded people in Perambalur District.

Activities of Avvai Mahalir Kuzhukalin Sangamam

Puthiyapathai – Integrated Rehabilitation Centre for Addicts (IRCA):

- Puthiyapathai – Integrated Rehabilitation Centre for Addicts (IRCA) has provided medical and psychological treatment to 185 addicts and out of that 160 were leading a drug free life. The recovered addicts were continuously followed up through home visits and telephone contact and supported to participate in Alcoholic Anonymous (AA) meeting organized by the project to ensure sobriety.
- The Honourable Union Minister of State for Social Justice and Empowerment, New Delhi visited the project, interacted with beneficiaries and appreciated the staff team for the quality services.
- Besides curative programme, the project has conducted 113 awareness programmes and covered 4000 people as part of preventive measures to school children, 100 days workers, auto drivers and other high risk population in Perambalur District.
- In order to make the treatment successful, the project has conducted 1465 individual counselings, 261 group therapies, 52 family therapies and periodical yoga & meditations for addicts and helped to lead a drug free life.
- Through peer educator and counsellor support, 196 home visits and 159 regular follow up counseling sessions were conducted and re-ensured sobriety of 160.
- As per the guidance of the Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment, organized event on Mission Life (Lifestyle for Environment) among school children, teachers and community members and thereby 128 were benefited. The students were educated on 75 action points such as Energy saved, Water saved, Single use



plastic reduction, e-waste reduction, Sustainable food systems, Waste reduction and Healthy lifestyle.

- 30 Alcoholic Anonymous (AA) meetings were conducted and 112 sober patients were participated. The sober were motivated with medal as an award and given guidance to remain as volunteers to the project.
- 06 college students from Department of Social Work did field work in the project and gained experience on addressing addicts, ill-effects of addiction and observed re-educative classes.
- Organized International Day Against Illicit Trafficking and Drug abuse in Perambalur District and sensitized school children and general public and thereby 60 were benefited. The programme was presided by the Inspector of Police, Perambalur District. IEC materails and Hnad bills were utilized and sensitized the public.
- The officials from NISD, District Child Protection Officer and college professors and Head of the Department of Social work were visited the project and given guidance.
- The counselors were trained by TTK-chennai and thereby the staff team extends quality services in the centre.



Avvai mahalir kuzhukalin Sangamam along with Govt. Women Arts and Science College, Veppur organized International Women's Day and sensitised the college students on preventive measures of gender violence, online safety, legal provision and women rights. 250 students were participated and benefited. Inspector, Kunnam Police station, College principal, Inspector from customs and counsellor from Govt Hospital were participated.



Nasha Mukht Bharat Abhiyaan (NMBA) - Navratra Saptah events

Nasha Mukht Bharat Abhiyaan Navratra Saptah events were organized by the Avvai Mahalir Kuzhukalin Sangamam at Perambalur District of Tamilnadu.

With the support of Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment, New Delhi, Avvai Mahalir Kuzhukalin Sangamam is running “Puthiyapathai” Integrated Rehabilitation Centre for Addicts (IRCA) programme at Perambalur District. Considering the circular received from the Under Secretary, Govt. of India, MSJE, New Delhi, the organization has conducted NMBA Navratra Saptah events for the students at Govt. Higher Secondary School, Ranjankudi village of Perambalur District.

Shri. Seeralan, the Deputy Superintendent of Police, Mangalamedu chaired the programme. Various events were organized for the students on substance abuse and the students actively participated and shared their thought provoking information on bringing Drug free India.



Competitions for the students:

From the above events, the students brought out issues pertaining to drug abuse and its ill-effects, impact of addiction over children, family and the society at large. The chief guests shared about the importance



of abstinence and roles on bringing Drug free India. The IRCA staff shared about the functions of IRCA programme in the District and briefed about Nasha Mukta Bharat Abhiyaan Navratra Saptah events supported by the Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment, New Delhi. Totally 220 students got benefited.

Prize Distribution:

The students participated in various events were awarded with prize and certificates and motivated to be a peer educators to educate other students in the school.

Anbu Home for Senior Citizen – Ariyalur District

- The deserted and neglected senior citizens were supported with shelter, food, medicines, yoga, recreation and rehabilitation assistance by running Home for Senior Citizens at free of cost. The Home functions at Ariyalur district with the strength of 25 residents.
- 12 Free medical camps were organized with the support of Govt. Hospital and given treatment for the ailments. The Village Health Nurse and medical team from Primary Health Centre extend their support for the elderly people to lead a healthy life.
- Important Days and events such as pongal, diwali, republic day and other religious festivals were organised at Home for Senior Citizens with the



participation of local stakeholders and the residents were motivated with prizes.

- The project leveraged material donations like household materials and entertainment items. The kind-hearted donors were thanked in person and through letter communication.
- Celebrated World Elders' Day programme and honoured senior citizens involved in various competitions organized by the project. The District officials were invited and the residents received prizes from their hands.
- Newspaper reading, watching television programs, hearing radio, cleaning home environment, carrom, chess, musical chair, ball game and group singing are some of the periodical entertainment activities conducted at Home. The residents feel at home and relaxed.
- The residents were engaged in yoga periodically with trained yoga master. The yoga helped residents to get relief from breathing trouble, knee pain and made them relax and comfortable. The project leveraged Old Age Pension for 05 elders from Govt.
- The District Social Welfare Officer, Extension officers were visited the project and given guidance.

Integrated complex of Special Home for Senior Citizens and Destitute Children

- Integrated complex of Special Home for Senior Citizens and Destitute children has taken care of 25 destitute and neglected elders and 24 children. With own source of funding, the organization is running the project by taking care of the poor and neglected elders in and around the district.
- 08 Free medical camps were organized with the help of Govt. Primary Health Centre and given treatment for their ailments.
- The residents were taken to nearby temple and festival as part of recreational activities. The project also mobilized material donations from public and extended better care and support to the residents.



- The children enjoy moving with elderly people by learning moral stories, traditional medicines and good characters.
- The District Social Welfare Officer, Extension officers and local medical team from Primary Health Centre visited the project and given guidance and support.
